MALAYSIAN CANDIDATES

- Registered Nurse with the Malaysian Nursing Board (MNB)
- Possess a Diploma/Bachelor in Nursing from a recognised institution accredited by MQA
- Possess current PC/RON for nurses from MNB before clinical placement (3.1.14)

INTERNATIONAL CANDIDATES/SPOUSES OF MALAYSIAN CITIZEN

- Registered with the Nursing Council of the country of origin
- Possess a Diploma / Bachelor in Nursing from a recognised institution accredited by the accreditation body of the country of origin
- Possess a current TPC from MNB before clinical placement (3.1.18)

- Minimum of 24 months of clinical working experience
- At least 3 months of working experience in perioperative nursing
 - Medically fit and free from physical or mental disabilities
- Not pregnant at the time of course enrollment or during the course
